WIKA Showcases Productivity by Completing Infrastructure Projects Amid Pandemic

Amid the Pandemic, WIKA continues to showcase its capabilities by completing several strategic projects on schedule, which all are inaugurated by President Joko Widodo:



Kuningan Dam, West Java

- Constructed by total cost project Rp513 billion, with a 25.9 million cubic metre capacity.
- Projected to continuously irrigate 3,000 hectares of rice fields for farmers including in the Kuningan, Cirebon, and Brebes regencies.

Bendo Dam, East Java

- Constructed by total cost project Rp1,1 trillion. The dam has a capacity of 43 million cubic metre.
- Projected to continuously irrigate 7,800 hectares of rice fields for farmers and will supply 370 litres of water per second.

Passelloreng Dam, South Sulawesi

- Constructed by total cost project Rp521 billion, with a 138 million cubic metre capacity.
- Projected to continuously irrigate 8,500 hectares of rice fields and increase the planting season for farmers in surrounding areas.

Sei Alalak Bridge, South Kalimantan

- Has 850 metres long and 20 metres wide with a construction cost of Rp278 billion.
- This bridge connects Banjarmasin with other regions in South Kalimantan and Central Kalimantan.

Serang-Panimbang Toll Road Section I, Banten

- With a length of 26.5 km that connect Serang and Rangkasbitung.
- This toll road will reduce the travel time from Jakarta to Tanjung Lesung to 1.5 to 2 hours from 4 to 5 hours.

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
